If your abstract is accepted and you agree to participate, you will be required to pay a reduced registration fee for the symposium and present your paper under ISA's guidelines.

- All authors/presenters must pay registration fee of \$150

- Draft papers or presentations: 15 September 2008
- Final papers or presentation: 10 October 2008
