**Macy's Makeovers & Mimosas** – 9:00am – 11:00am @ Hidalgo, Galleria IV. **The Water Wall at Williams Tower** - Situated near the Galleria at 2800 Post Oak Blvd, this city landmark is a cool and refreshing oasis that attracts visitors and locals in droves. **Bayou Bend a Unique Collection of Americana - Located at 1 Westcott Street at Memorial** - Bayou Bend, the magnificent home of Miss Ima Hogg, is the extraordinary legacy of a remarkable woman. Best known for her superb collection of American decorative arts, Miss Hogg was also largely responsible for Bayou Bend's innovative architecture and breathtaking gardens. The collection at Bayou Bend presently contains several thousand objects installed in some 28 period room settings that showcase American decorative arts from 1620 through 1870. Open Tuesday thru Saturday 10:00am – 5:00pm and Sunday 1:00pm – 5pm. Reservations are required. Adults \$10.00, Seniors \$8.50. Call 713-639-7750 for detailed information.

**Uptown Park/Galleria** - Uptown Park (a 20 minute walk from the Westin Galleria Hotel), is conveniently located in the Uptown/Galleria area of Houston. The center is on Uptown Park Blvd. at the northwest corner of Post Oak Blvd. and Loop 610, just north of San Felipe. This is a lifestyle center like no other – Houston’s elegant Italian-style piazza. Catering to life’s indulgences, the center is lined with shops, boutiques and cafés that create an intimate atmosphere with an emphasis on charm.

**Houston Arboretum & Nature Center** – Located approximately 3 miles from the Westin Galleria, at 4501 Woodway Drive, the Houston Arboretum & Nature Center is a 155 acre nature sanctuary with 5 miles of walking trails and is one of the few educational attractions in Houston which does not charge an admission fee. The grounds are open 7 days a week from 7:00am until 7:00pm and the building is open from 9:00am until 5:00pm.
