## Specifying Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems for Low NOx Measurements

In order to meet the requirements of the State Implementation Plan of the US Clean Air Act for the Houston-Galveston Ozone non-Attainment area, about 130 sources at four Dow sites (Deer Park, Freeport, La Porte, Texas City) will require the addition of Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems (CEMS) for on-line analysis of NOx, CO, and O2. A multi-functional team was formed to determine the most effective technology to meet Dow's CEMS requirements. The process involved parallel efforts to define the specifications for the local controller and the best technology to measure NOx at the concentration level lower than previously measured at Dow. After narrowing down the list of technically acceptable approaches by leveraging the efforts undertaken at the University of California, Riverside and General Electric Power Systems, comparative testing was completed at Dow laboratories to define a list of suppliers which met the technical objectives of accurate and stable measurements requiring a minimum of maintenance. From this work, a set of supplier combinations for these analyzers was identified to meet the needs of Dow. These combinations allowed a commodity choice from which Dow Purchasing could negotiate discounts and pricing.
