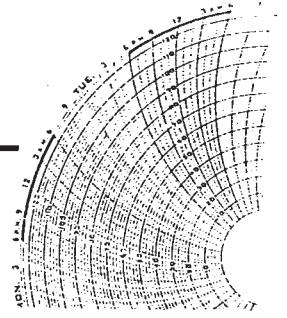

Integrated Access Control And Intrusion Detection Systems
