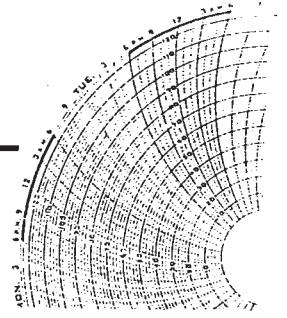

Electronic business strategy, the climate of e-business is influencing everyone.
