PLANT TOUR MICHELSON WATER RECLAMATION PLANT IRVINE RANCH WATER DISTRICT

TOUR BACKGROUND:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) became the first water district in the nation to obtain health department permits for unrestricted use permit for its reclaimed water. This permit allows the reclaimed water to be used for virtually everything but drinking. Currently, reclaimed water is delivered through a completely separate distribution system and is used in parks, schools, gold courses and streetscapes.

Waste water collected within IRWD is treated at the Michelson Water Reclamation plant using tertiary or advanced treatment. The plant tour will be conducted by the engineering and operation personnel and will include overview of preliminary treatment, primary and secondary clarifiers and active sludge process.

Continue ahead and veer to the right at the windmill, following signs to the Operations Center. Parking is available in the lot to the right of the Operations Center.
