PLANT TOUR

ORANGE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

Orange County Water District (OCWD) is responsible for supplying water to over 20 cities in Orange County with approximately 2 million residents. OCWD primarily re-charges the water from the Santa Ana River and imports water from Metropolitan Water District of Southern California. With one of the most sophisticated ground water replenishment program in the country, OCWD uses 646 wells and currently holds rights to all Santa Ana River reaching up to Prado dam in San Bernardino County.

ISA Orange County section has arranged a conducted tour of OCWD's Water Factory 21. The Water Factory 21 is a water purification plant that makes treated waste water from the Orange County Sanitation District and purifies it to beyond drinking water standards and then injects it into shallow aquifers near the coast to form fresh water barrier blocking sea water intrusion. This water eventually becomes part of the ground water basin and our water supply.
