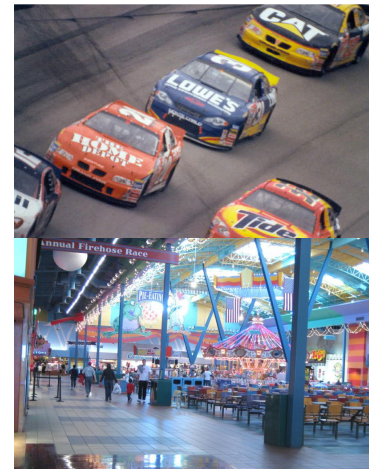

This year's Concord location has a bit of everything – no matter what your interests may be.
