Following the deadlines below, all papers must be submitted in electronic format (MS Word), suitable for publication in the proceedings. In addition, slide presentation materials must be provided in electronic format (MS Powerpoint) prior to the symposium for review and approval. A publication release form will also be required for all approved papers.
